EMUNI Summer 2009 Courses: EMUNI co-founding institutions offer postgraduate courses. All participants will receive a Certificate of Attendance issued by EMUNI University. Participants that will successfully complete their study obligations will receive the Transcript of Records with the course specification (ECTS, grade...) from responsible institution.

**Teaching Methods:** courses will be delivered on the basis of blended learning, a combination of on-line (on-line activities should start approximately one month before the course starting date) and face-to-face-tuition.

**Methods of assessment:** active participation, written or/and oral exam, final assignment (it is usually sent one month after the conclusion of the course).

**Professors:** each course will be delivered by 2 or 3 professors coming from EMUNI co-founding institutions.

**Social Programme:** trips and other social events will be organised.

**Roundtables:** two public roundtables will be organised during the face to face tuition on the selected topic.
