Applying for EMUNI Summer 2010 courses and grants: for registration, grants and administrative arrangements, please contact the responsible institution that offers the course.

Deadlines: approximately 4 – 6 weeks before the face-to-face tuition.



Teaching Methods: courses will be delivered on the basis of blended learning, a combination of on-line (on-line activities should start approximately one month before the course starting date) and face-to-face tuition.

Methods of assessment: active participation, written or/and oral exam, final assignment (it is usually submitted one month after the conclusion of the course).

Professors: each course will be delivered by 2 or 3 professors coming from EMUNI member institutions (EU countries and non-EU countries of the UfM).

Social Programme: trips to cultural and national heritage of the region and other social events will be organised.

Roundtables: roundtables on selected topics will be organised during the face-to-face tuition.

Certificate of attendance / Transcript of record: all participants will receive a Certificate of Attendance issued by EMUNI University and/or responsible institutions. Participants that will successfully complete their study obligations will receive the Transcript of Records with the course specification (ECTS, grade) from the responsible institution.
