Master Study Programmes

Master Study Programmes

EMUNI University will create a network of specialised postgraduate study programmes among Euro-Mediterranean universities. International comparability will be ensured with respect to credits, courses, as well as awarded scientific and professional titles. In terms of fields of study, special emphasis will be given to topics related to the Euro-Mediterranean region. Complete study programmes (or parts of them) will be carried out at several universities, co-founders of the Euro-Mediterranean University (EMUNI).

Some characteristics of the "EMUNI label" Masters and related activities:

- with respect to the programme selected, a single university is responsible for issuing the selected degree,
- a minimum of 3 universities will take part in conducting the programme, of which at least one from a Southern Mediterranean country,
- each course will be delivered by multiple faculty,
- courses will be delivered to cohorts of 20 to 30 students, of whom at least 5 from non-EU Euro-Mediterranean countries,
- while each programme will be conducted at the location of the university which will issue the selected degree, students will also take courses (gaining 15-20 ECTS) at Center EMUNI in Slovenia over a four-week period,
- besides quality assurance and assessment carried out by the university responsible for the programme, the innovative and intercultural aspects of the Master study programmes will be observed and assessed by EMUNI experts,
- a range of teaching methods will be applied including face-to-face tuition, on-line instruction, project work, internship,
- for admission requirements, please contact the institutions responsible for the programme (see table above), etc.

Euro-Mediterranean Summer School

A 2nd Euro-Mediterranean Summer School is planned to be conducted from June to September 2009 in Slovenia and also at least five other universities in the Euro-Mediterranean area. Accredited master courses (with ECTS value) will be carried out.

Doctoral Research Seminars

We are planning to organize special seminars for doctoral students. Groups with a maximum of 10 doctoral students and up to 4 professors will be able to explore a variety of research fields related to the Euro-Mediterranean area. During a two-week stay in Slovenia, students will have the opportunity to elaborate their doctoral theses and write research papers. In addition, they will be given the possibility to develop an interdisciplinary approach in an intercultural environment.

The seminars planned for the academic year 2008/09 will be delivered in two terms: from 2nd to 14th of March and from 4th to 16th of May. Seminars will focus on the following areas of study: De-pollution of the Mediterranean, Maritime and Land Highways, Civil Protection, Alternative Energies: Mediterranean Solar Plan. One university will be selected to co-ordinate the seminar from each topic. More information in December 2008.
